Good evening fellow club members and guests.

Tonight, we're paying tribute to 1st Lieutenant Ryan D. Rawl of Lexington, who died June 20, 2012 in Khost Afghanistan.

Lt. Rawl was commanding a South Carolina National Guard Military Police platoon operating a checkpoint in a crowded market where they were doing fingerprinting and retina scans, looking for insurgents and searching for explosives. In the crowd, a suicide bomber detonated a vest packed with small ball bearings killing 3 guardsman and wounding 5, also killing 21 Afghans and wounded many more. This was the deadliest day for SC National guard since the Korean War.

All three Guardsmen were with the 133rd Military Police Company based in Timmonsville. Lt. Rawl received numerous decorations and honors including the Bronze Star, The Purple Heart, The Combat Action Badge, The SC Medal of Valor and The SC Meritorious Service Medal.

Lieutenant Rawl had served with the Richland County Sheriff's Department prior to deployment and was a Citadel graduate. While attending The Citadel, he received the Mark Clark Award for his outstanding service on the Honor Court.

Lieutenant Rawl's supervisor, Sheriff Leon Lott said this about him: "Rawl was willing to stand up to protect and serve; it was with that same pride he did so in his military uniform. He was an example to men and women who wear the uniform everywhere".

As an indication of our respect for Lieutenant Rawl and others who gave their lives for our country, the club places US flags around our community several times a year. Each flag has a yellow ribbon attached with the name of a fallen hero.

Lieutenant Rawl, we salute you and your sacrifice on our behalf.
